Peat Fiber Biofilter

Owners have found many aesthetically pleasing ways to landscape around the modules.

- Light materials such as pine straw, bark, wood chips, or sedum blankets may be placed on the module lids. The material will be removed during maintenance and then replaced.
- Landscape around the modules with shallow rooted plants. Check with your local landscaper or plant nursery for shallow rooted plants best suited for your environment.
- Plants should be at least 5 feet from the modules.
- Filter fabric should be placed beneath landscaping materials to prevent blockage of the vent holes.



Landscaping Do's and Don'ts:

- Do ensure vent holes are open to allow free air movement
- Do ensure rainwater drains way from the modules
- Don't plant anything on top of the module lids
- Don't drive over the modules or drainfield
